


Suppose you mix potassium chloride and lead nitrate solutions. What is the precipitate that forms?

Answer:

The chemical reaction between potassium chloride and lead nitrate occur following the molecular equation:



or ionic equation:



So, the white precipitate which is formed in this reaction is PbCl_2 .
