What is the difference between a binary and non binary compound?

Answer:

A binary compound is a chemical compound that contains exactly two (2) different elements.

Examples: H₂O, NaCl, HCl, NH₃.

Non-binary compound is a combination of three (3) and more different elements.

Examples: H_2SO_4 , $C_6H_{12}O_6$, $Ca(OH)_2$, $KFe[Fe(CN)_6]$.
