What is the difference between a binary and non binary compound?

Answer:

A binary compound is a chemical compound that contains exactly two (2) different elements.

Examples: H_2O , NaCl , HCl , NH_3 .

Non-binary compound is a combination of three (3) and more different elements.

Examples: H_2SO_4 , $\text{C}_6\text{H}_{12}\text{O}_6$, $\text{Ca}(\text{OH})_2$, $\text{KFe}[\text{Fe}(\text{CN})_6]$.
