## Answer on Question #54521 – Chemistry – Other

## Question:

The recommended adult dose for penicillin is 200 mg PO Q6H.

What would the dose be for a 2yr-old infant? (Use Fried's rule to complete the problem.)

**Solution:** 

Formula:

Child dose = 
$$\left(\frac{Age\ of\ child\ in\ month}{150\ lbs}\right)$$
 Average adult dose.

The dose for a 2yr-old infant is

Child dose = 
$$\frac{24}{150 \text{ lbs}} 200 \text{ mg} = 32 \text{ mg}.$$

Answer: 32 mg.
