

Answer on Question #69612, Chemistry / General Chemistry

Many offices and schools have already banned the sale of bottled water within their premises. As an expert in environmental chemistry, you have been hired by the Ministry of the environment to do research and provide advice on the following issue: What impact would a total ban on water sold in plastic bottles have on Ontario consumers and on Ontario's environment?

Answer:
