## Solution

Active mass is the concentration of a reacting substance expressed usually in moles per liter. Converting grams of nitrogen to moles:

 $7 \text{ g N}_2 (1 \text{ mol N}_2 / 28 \text{ g N}_2) = 0.25 \text{ mol N}_2.$ 

Calculating the molarity of nitrogen in the container:

 $0.25 \text{ mol N}_2/\ 2\ L = 0.125 \text{ mol/L}.$ 

Answer: 0.125 mol/L.

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
