Indicator - a connection that allows you to visualize the change in the concentration of a substance or a component, for example, in a solution with titration, or quickly determine pH, eH and other parameters.

Modern indicator strips can be made with a dye-indicator grafted to cellulose or other polymer. This makes them resistant to washing out, up to repeated use.
