
Answer on Question 65584 -Economics - Microeconomics

Imagine that to preserve the traditional way of life in small fishing villages, a government decides to impose a price floor that will guarantee all fishermen a certain price for their catch.



Establishing a price floor would lead to the fact that everyone in the village will want to be fishermen and the market supply of fish and the catch will increase (up to Q2). At the same time putting a price higher than the equilibrium one would reduce demand to Q1. Thus, there is a surplus in the market. if the situation will last for a long time, this can lead to local ecological disaster, because the fish will be exterminated and putrefy unclaimed.
