

Answer on question 37877 – Math – Abstract algebra

If a pizza costs £2.85 (Ex VAT) to produce and is sold to the guest for £8.29 (Ex VAT), what percentage gross profit is made from this dish? (To 1 decimal place)

Solving

The gross profit from one pizza is $8.29 - 2.85 = 5.44\text{£}$

To find percentage gross profit we should gross profit divide by profit and multiply by 100 (to find the percent):

$$\frac{5.44}{8.29} * 100 \approx 70\%.$$

Answer: 70%.
