## Answer on Question \#46732 - Math - Algebra

There are 45 students riding another bus to the football game. There are seven more girls than boys. How many boys are on the bus?

## Solution:

Let x be the number of boys on the bus.
There are seven more girls than boys, thus $y=x+7$ is the number of girls on the bus.
There are 45 students riding a bus:

$$
\begin{gathered}
x+y=45 \\
x+(x+7)=45 \\
2 x=45-7 \\
2 x=38 \\
x=19
\end{gathered}
$$

Answer: there are 19 boys on the bus.
