

Answer on Question #85095 – Math – Statistics and Probability

Question

True or false.

A resort employs 3500 managers and staff. To ascertain their employees' opinions of a proposed health insurance plan, 350 employees are surveyed at random. The proportion of the 350 employees who favor the health insurance plan represents a parameter in this scenario.

Solution

The statement in the question is False.

Parameter is a descriptive measure of a population (not a sample).

Answer: False.
