

Answer on Question #41502 – Physics – Other

Question.

The resistivity, R , of a wire is given by:

- 1) ρLA
- 2) $AL\rho$
- 3) $A\rho L$
- 4) ρIA

Solution.

The electrical resistance R of the material is:

$$R = \rho \frac{L}{A}$$

ρ is the electrical resistivity;

L is the length of the piece of material;

A is the cross-sectional area of the specimen.

So, the electrical resistivity of the material is:

$$\rho = R \frac{A}{L}$$
