Answer on Question 68080, Physics, Other

Question:

A bicycle tire pump has a piston with area $0.40 in^2$. If a person exerts a force of 23 lb on the piston while inflating a tire, what pressure does this produce on the air in the pump?

Solution:

By the definition of the pressure, we get:

$$P = \frac{F}{A} = \frac{23 \ lb}{0.40 \ in^2} = 57.5 \ Psi.$$

Answer:

 $P = 57.5 \, Psi.$

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
