

## Question #80439

One of the following 10 statements generates an error. Which one? (Your answer should be a number between 1 and 10.)

```
x = [1,"abcd",2,"efgh",[3,4]] # Statement 1
```

```
y = x[0:50] # Statement 2
```

```
z = y # Statement 3
```

```
w = x # Statement 4
```

```
x[1] = x[1] + 'd' # Statement 5
```

```
x[1][1] = 'y' # Statement 6
```

```
y[2] = 4 # Statement 7
```

```
z[0] = 0 # Statement 8
```

```
w[4][0] = 1000 # Statement 9
```

```
a = (x[4][1] == 4) # Statement 10
```

### Answer:

Since the Python strings are immutable, the statement `x[1][1] = 'y'` will generate a `TypeError`.

So, the answer is
